





SPISE 8 Attending Countries



More than 50 participants from 19 European countries and from 4 other European countries

- Based on EU SUD Directive 128/2009 all PAE in EU had be inspected before November 26th 2016
- In 2023 all PAE should be inspected at least 2 or 3 times
- Lot of experience in different countries, also with difficulties/challenges



Main objectives of the present Workshop:

- 1. Learn from experiences of the participants, share experiences, participate active in the workshops, make contacts.
- 2. Update about the present situation of PAE inspection within Member States.
- 3. How to deal with 'new' technologies and minor PAE
- 4. Workshop quality control

General conclusions coming out from the 7th SPISE Workshop held in 2018

- 1. Need to improve the PAE inspection activities in MS mainly in terms of:
 - Percentage of PAE inspected
 - Inspections quality
- 2. Improve the final users training/ information about the mandatory PAE inspection and its advantage is essential (e.g considering this as a mandatory topic in the PP use license training courses)
- 3. MS controls of the respect of both Machinery and SUD Directive requirements is really limited and its improvement is needed and should be addressed also from Commission

General conclusions coming out from the 7th SPISE Workshop held in 2018

- 4. SPISE Advice seems and useful tool to fulfill SUD Directive requirements for those PAE for witch is still not available an Harmonized Standard.
- 5. The really dangerous increasing lack of specific professional figure in EU with competence on pesticide application technologies shall be solved.
- 6. SPISE Community will go ahead with its voluntary activities in helping MS and Commission in improve the complete adoption of the SUD Directive in EU countries, but some support is needed.
